

Statement of Work:

Fred Cohen & Associates (FCA) will add a Road-map report to a Security Architecture Future study for [CLIENT]. This will consist of the following items:

1. FCA personnel will collect current state information during its 2 days of scheduled telephone meetings with CLIENT.
2.
